EDITOR'S NOTE: The following is the text of the Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967 (Pub. L. 90-202) (ADEA), as amended, as it appears in volume 29 of the United States Code, beginning at section 621. The ADEA prohibits employment discrimination against persons 40 years of age or older.

The Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967

.165 Increase or decrease in compensation for failure to comply with safety law -- Compensation not payable if employee falsely represents physical condition or medical history at time of employment. .170 Repealed, effective January 1, 1973. .175 Lien for compensation. .180 Compensation claim not assignable -- Exempt from debts -- Exception.
